



Embracing Diversity and Authenticity: Hola @ Remitly Participates in the Hispanic Leadership Summit

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On December 6-7, 2023, Hola @ Remitly attended the [We Are All Human Foundation's](#) two-day [Hispanic Leadership Summit](#) in New York City. Hola @ Remitly, an employee-led affinity group, focuses on uniting Hispanic employees to nurture an inclusive environment and support career development. She emphasized the importance of [leading authentically](#), regardless of one's position or background, and encouraged others not to shy away from seeking opportunities.
