As the holiday season approaches, remittance flows increase, reflecting the spirit of generosity and cultural traditions that unite families across borders. December marks the peak of remittance send volume, where holiday spending not only strengthens family bonds but also influences local economies.

December: The Season of Sending

Remitly analyzed U.S. remittance send volumes for November and December in both 2022 and 2023. We found that in December 2023, remittance volumes originating from the U.S. increased by more than 10% from November, marking it as the highest month of the year for cross-border financial support. This aligns with global celebrations such as Christmas, Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, and New Year, making it an especially meaningful time for many families receiving these funds.

Top Recipients: The Philippines, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, Colombia, and India stood out as the primary destinations for these holiday remittances.

The Broader Impact of Holiday Remittances

Holiday remittances extend beyond personal gifting and household needs. They play a critical role in stabilizing economies and currencies, especially in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs). In 2023, Remitly customers sent more than \$39 billion², supporting family and loved ones around the world.

- *Economic Boost:* In the Philippines, remittance inflows in December are projected to drive a 5% appreciation in the peso by year-end, according to Australia & New Zealand Banking Group forecasts, reversing earlier losses. This pattern has repeated in six of the past seven years³, demonstrating the powerful macroeconomic role of remittance-driven currency flows.
- *Essential Support:* Globally, a significant portion of remittances in December are directed toward necessities like food, medical expenses, and education. A



Remitly survey¹ revealed that 54% of remittance funds support household needs, while 26% are allocated for special occasions, including holidays—a testament to the holiday spirit of giving.

Why It Matters: Beyond spreading joy, these funds support economic growth and stability, and alleviate financial pressures on millions of families around the world⁴.
