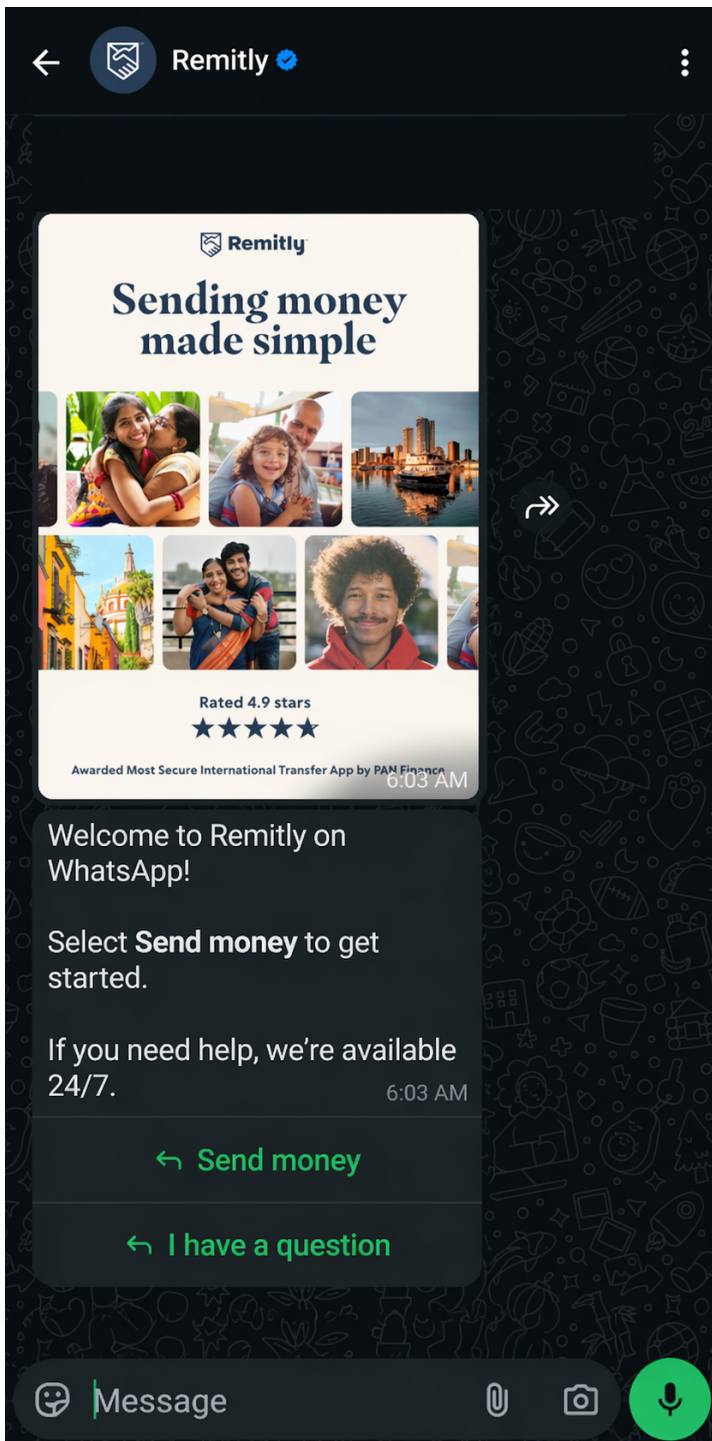


Remitly on WhatsApp Just Got An Upgrade
